Parent Meeting & Technology Safety: Please join us after school, on October 30 (from 4:30-5:30PM) for our first Parent Meeting of the year, where we will be answering any questions you have for the upcoming school year as well as sharing our vision for the school and this school year. The Lord has put a lot on our heart for this year and we would love to share it with you as well as put His vision into action.

At the meeting, we would love for you to stay a bit longer, as we follow up with **Technology Safety**.

At the school, we have monitoring systems and internet safety systems in place that block inappropriate sites and material from school devices, but we would like to share with all of you how important it is to monitor your child's technology usage and ways to do that.

This year, we have noticed some inappropriate saved files on some student's personal accounts and we want to have an open discussion about ways to help families prevent this. On average, the first inappropriate use of electronics starts very young, so please do come to the meeting.

Many electronic devices give students free range to anything they may be tempted to view and **without limits and security**, they are open to unlimited amounts of inappropriate sites and images. It is so important to check your child's device on a regular basis and to set limits and boundaries. We'd love to help and talk with you more about the many ways to do this.
