

STUDENTS ARE HELD TO CHRISTIAN VALUES AT ALL TIMES.

We expect students to come ready to have some fun, in a respectful and glorifying manner.

Modest clothing must be worn at all times (please follow school dress code in regard to covering the body). There are no exceptions to this.

Students will be expected to make good decisions and show self control. If students are incapable of doing this, parents will be asked to immediately come and pick up their child(ren). They will also receive a one year probation from any future trips.

Students should come ready to serve without complaint and grow in relationship with the Lord.

Students should be ready to participate with the group in planned activities.

FCS High School Overnight Packing List - What to Bring

- WARM CLOTHES (SUITABLE FOR WASHINGTON WEATHER AND COLDER BEACH WEATHER)
- TOILETRIES (SHAMPOO, SOAP, TOOTHBRUSH, TOOTHPASTE, HAIRBRUSH/COMB, ETC.)
- SLEEPING BAG OR BLANKET AND PILLOW-WARM ENOUGH TO SLEEP WITH AT NIGHT (SLEEP MAT, IF YOU WOULD LIKE)
- TOWELS (FOR SHOWER AND BEACH)
- SNACKS (FOR THE ROAD AND OTHER)
- BIBLE (PHONE IS NOT ACCEPTABLE)
- FLASHLIGHT
- SUNBLOCK
- SUNGLASSES/SUN HAT (OPTIONAL)
- WATER SHOES (OPTIONAL) AND SHOES TO WALK/HIKE IN
- BATHING SUIT (OPTIONAL): IF BATHING SUITS ARE PACKED,
 - FEMALES: MUST BE FULL COVERAGE, ONE PIECE AND STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A LARGE DARK TSHIRT OVER TOP AS WELL AS BAGGY SHORTS THAT ARE MODEST IN LENGTH (READ SCHOOL POLICIES).
 - MALES: MUST FOLLOW SCHOOL POLICY IN REGARD TO SHORTS LENGHT AND COVERAGE AS WELL AS WEAR A LARGE DARK TSHIRT

ALL BAGS WILL BE CHECKED BEFORE DEPARTING. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU DO NOT BRING UNNECESSARY ITEMS AND PLEASE ASK IF YOU ARE NOT SURE. AS ALWAYS, NO WEAPONS OF ANY NATURE ARE ALLOWED NOR ADDITIONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES (IPADS, ETC.).

Students will be allowed to bring one bag plus bedding with them, so please make sure unnecessary items are not packed. Bedding must be able to sit on a student's lap.
